Agility Regulations & Registration

Registration Information

Copies of vaccines are required at time of registration. Dogs are required to be current on their Rabies vaccine and have had a Distemper/Parvo vaccine within the previous three years. If you prefer to not vaccinate every three years, we will accept a yearly titer instead of the vaccine. We do not require the kennel cough vaccine for our healthy agility dogs.

There will be **no refunds** given for classes should you elect to not attend, no matter what the reason, including vacation, work, illness, or injury. This includes if your dog is excused due to behavior problems.

When at class, do not allow urinating on the equipment. If that happens, please tell us so that we can immediately clean the area.

Registration, payment and vaccine records must be received by **Club-Doggie** by the class start. Classes fill on a first-come, first-serve basis. We can **not** hold a spot for you without a deposit of **at least** fifty percent of your total class fees.

Attendance

We will call and/or email you if class is cancelled. If you have any questions about the weather on the evening of class, please call or email. Don't assume class will be cancelled if it's cloudy or windy or even raining. If *we* cancel a class, make up classes may be scheduled at the end of the final session, or if possible, on an alternate day/time during the current session.

If your *dog* must miss a class, you should still come to class to see what to practice with him when he's feeling better.

If *you* must be absent from class, please call to see if there is another class you can attend.

Female dogs in season can come to class as long as they are wearing britches.

Equipment

Absolutely no choke chains, gentle leaders, or pinch collars will be used on the equipment. We encourage the use of flat buckle collars and/or harnesses. All dogs should have a 6 foot leash.

Agility is an athletic sport. We recommend you wear appropriate running shoes and encourage you to do warm-up activities for you and your dog.

Class structure

While agility is great fun, this is still “school” for you and your dog. Please be respectful of other people, their dogs, and their space. We understand that socialization is very important for dogs, but training class is not the appropriate time for that. Besides, if your dog is visiting with someone else, they aren’t paying attention to you!

To keep class moving along, everyone will help set jump bars, straighten chutes, and make sure the equipment is ready for the next dog to run.

Expect to do homework between classes. Most homework does not require agility equipment, and when it does, a loaner or rental may be available to you. Club-Doggie also offers some equipment for purchase.

If we feel your dog cannot safely participate in agility because of a physical limitation (age, weight, disability), we may ask you to skip certain exercises or to get a health clearance from your veterinarian. In any case, we will use our best judgment and have the dog’s best interests in mind.

Bring to Class

Bring your dog to class hungry along with an assortment of different small treats and his favorite toy. Please wait until after class to feed your dog.

Statement of Responsibility and Waiver of Liability

I understand that agility is physically demanding sport for both handler and dog. I understand that the agility training at Club-Doggie is held at a private residence in the presence of other dogs and their owners. I represent that I am in good health and that my dog is in good health; that my dog is friendly and not a hazard to other persons or dogs: that I will examine the equipment provided for the class, along with the premises, prior to permitting my dog to engage in the agility activities. I understand a variety of equipment is used which could result in injury to my dog or me. I understand that it is my sole responsibility as a student to ensure my own safety and the safety of my dog. If at any time I am uncomfortable with the safety of a situation it is my responsibility to notify the instructor that I will not be participating in that aspect of the training program.

I will not hold, Kama Rueschenberg, Jubie Rueschenberg, Samantha Soltesz, Club-Doggie, any person contracted to and/or employed by Club-Doggie and/or any member of their families responsible for any loss, damage and/or injury to any person, dog, and/or property whether it is the result of accident, negligence, or any other cause. I further agree to assume full responsibility and liability for any and all injury or damage caused in any way by my dog(s) and/or myself.

I completely understand that I am training my dog and myself at my own risk. It is understood that during the course of training classes, if I or my dog is injured or becomes ill in any way, including being bitten by another dog in class, I will not hold, Kama Rueschenberg, Jubie Rueschenberg, Samantha Soltesz, Club-Doggie, any person contracted to and/or employed by Club-Doggie and/or any member of their families liable in any way.

I understand that I may not bring guests and/or children to the premises without the permission of Kama Rueschenberg or Jubie Rueschenberg or other individual contracted to Club-Doggie. Guests and guardians of children will be required to sign a liability statement.

Club-Doggie reserves the right to refuse training opportunities to anyone who does not display good sportsmanship, consideration toward others, does not follow the rules and safety policies and/or in any way is a threat to the safety of others.
